

@ a Glance

Because we place so much value over your life and appreciate your fellowshipping with us, whether a member, regular visitor or first time visitor, we are delighted to give you a general overview of our church; what we do and where to find things. If you have any questions or concerns, please just speak to one of our leaders or the person who welcomed you at the door.

You probably entered via the main entrance in the café area. Our TOILETS are located there and drinks are served from the counter after service.

The CHILDREN have their service in the SMALL HALL which is accessible through the main gates by the side of the church. Our Sunday celebration starts at 1:30pm and usually lasts for about 3 hours with exciting moments with the Lord and one another. In our service, allow the Holy Spirit to lead and direct in the following activities:

SETTING THE ALTERS: Powerful, Passionate Intercessory Prayer sessions on all issues and also seeking the Holy Spirit's leading for the day.

SUNDAY SCHOOL: A time to discuss and systematically study the Word of God for all age groups. You will be allocated a class by the superintendent who will also give you a Sunday School book (6 monthly manual).

PRAISES & WORSHIP: Our worship is celebrated with singing, drumming, clapping and dancing. You will hear shouts of "Praise the Lord, "Hallelujah", "Amen" and many more as an expression of joy, praise and grace. Songs and hymns are picked from all over the world and we sing, clap and dance to the glory of God. You will find the

words of the songs on the screen so you can sing along.

WELCOME & ANNOUNCEMENTS: It's our custom to warmly welcome everyone at every service and also throw emphases on forthcoming events and activities. We also acknowledge and celebrate with each other; Birthdays, Anniversaries, Weddings, Dedications, Travels, Successes and every special moment. Visitors and celebrants are

SONG MINISTRATION: Our choir; 'Echoes of the Crown' will treat you to a melodious music to settle and assure you of God's eminent presence.

prayed for by the ministerial team.

OFFERINGS, TITHES, SACRIFICES, SEEDS and GIFTS: At every service, we give opportunity for people to make monetary sacrifices, gifts, offerings, gifts, etc to the Lord. This is a generous, spontaneous and voluntary showing of gratitude to the Lord at any time of the service. We also believe in tithing (10 percent) of your increase as stated in the Holy Scriptures to be paid weekly or monthly depending on the individual.

We encourage that all monetary offerings be put in envelopes and GIFT AIDED if you are a UK tax payer.

WORD MINISTRATION: We believe in the Holy Scriptures (Old & New Testament, excluding the apocrypha) as God's Word to us. Readings are made from the Bible and therefore everyone is encouraged to personally own one.

At every service, we allow the Lord to speak to us through His servant. Our

speakers are Spirit filled people of God who take time to pray, study obtain revelation from God and passionately share with us. We acknowledge the office and ministry of Pastors, Apostles, Prophets, Teachers and Evangelist operating in the spiritual gifts to edify and build the body of Christ.

Our sermon times are very interactive, educative and prophetic and people in a relaxed mode react to the power of the Word. Questions are not allowed on Sundays. However, if you are unsure about anything, you can come to our Friday teaching service.

COMMUNION SERVICE: Our Lord Jesus Christ encourages us to observe the Holy Communion as often as we can. We do this monthly (1st Sunday of the month) and it is not for only members of our local church or Assemblies of God but rather all believers (including visitors). You are welcomed to partake of it if you are a believer regardless of your denomination.

PRAYER & FELLOWSHIP: We believe in the power of prayer and the assurance of the Lord to hear our request and answer our needs. Therefore our services are spiced with powerful prophetic prayers which we all do in our own words and understanding.

Added to congregational prayers, the ministers will also pray with and for you regarding anything and everything. There are testimonies of God's miraculous hands in our gatherings. After the service, people stay on and interact with each other and the ministers.

HOME CELL FELLOWSHIP: As part of our community impact programme, and also to interact with the community, we hold monthly home fellowships all across London. This is where members who live in a particular community, invites

neighbours and friend to their home for a cup of tea, coffee, soft drinks and biscuits. After which they pray for their street and community. There is a home group near you and I encourage you to link up and enjoy fellowship in a small group (Eltham, Orpington, Catford, Lewisham, North London and Woolwich).

The Holy Spirit leads and dictates the shape and form of our services for we are not tied to an order of service. However as a guide to our wonderful visitors, these are some of the things that happen in our service:



Leadership Quotient

We need an established Church!. This means we need established leaders, who will lead the established church not the building, but you and I. Jesus said in Matthew 16:18 "...I will build (establish) my church..."

God in his own wisdom set up leadership for His established Church. First in the OT in Exodus 18:19-27. Levites in the Old Testament are the prototype of deacons in New Testament. This is seen in Num. 3:5-13 were Aaron the priest had helpers. Secondly, in the New Testament we see elders and deacons introduced Acts 6:1-3; 1 Tim 3:8-13. The office of the deacon is not mans invention. The Holy Spirit Himself

decreed that there should be such to serve the Church. These are believers who are not fulltime spiritual leaders. Usually they work under the elders, pastors. I Tim. 3:8 make this clear. they help leaders in directing groups of believers Judges 17:6

Every job needs qualifications Before these leaders are chosen, the Holy Spirit has provided a standard by which they are to be chosen.

The Word of God is the final decree in this matter and must be followed implicitly.

However, before we consider the qualifications, let's look at:

- 1. Non-Qualifications
- a. Money
- b. Education c. Political Influence

- 2. Disqualifications: Personal Character
- Drinking
- b. Loving money and not paying tithes
- c. Being double tongued
- d. Having more than one wife
- e. Having a wife who is a slanderer
- Not faithful in all things
- q. Not serious

Now let's consider the qualifications (the spiritual life) of a leader as outlined in 1 Timothy 3:

- 1. Faith Deacon must hold on to it with a clear conscience
- 2. Full of the Holy Ghost
- 3. Full of Wisdom
- 4. Proved over a period of time Let them be tested over a period of time
- 5. Must be found blameless Moral purity
- 6. Pure conscience
- 7. Be of good report. (Both inside and outside) not a novice
- 8. Serious
- Husband of one wife must not be unfaithful to spouse either in their actual conduct with others or in their minds
- 10. Rule their own house well

For this honorable office of deaconship which simply means servant, the Lord provides special gifts and grace for such workers. He requires humble souls who are prepared to embark on the learning journey with Him. And this will come when we have the consciousness that the work is the Lords', the glory is also His.

The message is "Jesus Still Loves the Sinner". We shall all assemble at pastor's residence at 4:00pm




